EECBG - PLANNING

\$16.6<u>K</u>

The Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program provides DIRECT funding for efforts such as development and implementation of an energy efficiency and conservation strategy, audits, development and implementation of programs for energy efficiency and clean transportation, lighting, renewable energy and more.

GRID RESILIENCE

\$294K

Program to strengthen and modernize the power grid against extreme weather and other natural disasters exacerbated by the climate crisis. Awards made on a rolling basis as applications received.

\$499K

TRIBAL HOME ELECTRIFICATION & APPLIANCE REBATES

Full program requirements coming fall 2023. Funding to electrify and replace appliances and HVAC systems.
